EQUESTRIAN PORTRAITS	Starting Price
Pencil drawing of a favorite snapshot (not a close-up portrait), horse and rider (11x14)	\$400
Person: Riding Horse: 3/4 to full figure (not a close-up portrait)	\$2,500
Person: Head / Shoulders / Hands Horse: head or head & chest (close, detailed portrait)	\$4,500
Grand Scale Work: Person: Full figure, standing Horse: Full figure (close, detailed portrait)	\$7,000
<i>Sizes vary depending on the composition and customer preference.</i>	

- *Add 50% for each additional person or horse shown
- *Add 30% for complex clothing or background
- *Add 30% for each pet shown

My process begins with meeting the customers and spending some time photographing them, and discussing what they wish to capture with the portrait. This typically takes about 2 hours. Then I will sort through all the images, choose a few that I think are the best, and show them to the customer. After the composition has been agreed upon, the actual painting will begin.

I will work from provided photos, if they are good enough in terms of lighting and high quality. If applicable, permission from the photographer will also be needed.

Depending on the number of subjects in the painting, and the amount of desired detail in the background,

the process typically takes 2-3 months, although that may be extended for larger/more complex paintings. Portraits that are being ordered as gifts need to be ordered with enough time not only for the piece to be created, but also for the paint to dry (typically another 4-6 weeks). Paintings are completed in the order in which they are commissioned, or based on deadlines if applicable.

Payment Terms:

The work begins with a signed contract that details the specifics of the project and a 50% non-refundable deposit. Customer satisfaction is guaranteed, and reasonable changes will be made upon request. Final payment signifies the customer's complete satisfaction with the painting, and the work is delivered upon receipt of the final payment. Framing and travel (if needed) are not included in the price of the work.
